I Woodwind Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 440 West Harbour £245,000 Rerth 52

This Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 440 is a meticulously maintained sailing yacht built in 2017. This shoal draft version features a three-cabin, two-heads layout with grey Cedar interior, offering six double berths plus a saloon conversion. Powered by a 57hp Yanmar engine with approximately 564 hours and a retractable bow thruster. The yacht is equipped with Elvstrom valeted sails (2018), high-quality Sparcraft rigging, and extensive navigation and safety gear

2 Display Boat Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 350 Sales Area £205,000

This 2024 Marc Lombard-designed boat is the latest iteration in the Sun Odyssey range, featuring Jeanneau's unique walkaround decks, making it ideal for short-handed sailing. It has a two-cabin layout, shoal keel, and comes with extensive equipment including a Yanmar 29hp engine, Raymarine navigation suite, and full shore power system. The boat is a superb family cruiser, easy to handle and fun to sail, and is available ex VAT for qualifying purchasers, with part exchange and marine finance options.

3 Mistress Hallberg-Rassy 39 Sales Area £179,995

The 2001 Hallberg-Rassy 39 "Mistress," is a well-maintained offshore cruiser featuring impressive performance and shorthanded sailing capability typical of German Frers' designs. Six to seven berths across three cabins, a well-equipped galley, ample storage, and a range of modern amenities such as Webasto central heating and a TV system. The mechanical systems are in excellent condition, powered by a 57hp Volvo Penta MD22P.

4 Fair Rose Najad 373 Berth G196 £157,500

This Najad 373 is a high-quality blue water cruiser, built in 2002. This well-presented yacht, currently with its second owner, is ready for coastal and long-range cruising. Key features include a reliable 56hp Yanmar 4JH3-E marine diesel engine, recent bow thruster, extensive navigation and sail equipment, central heating and a winter cover. The yacht has been meticulously maintained, with regular engine servicing and various upgrades including a new cutlass bearing, stern gland, and a heat exchanger.

5 Skylark Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 349 Sales Area £149,950

This is a 2022 example that comes with a lifting keel, teak interior, and three double sleeping cabins, providing ample comfort and versatility. Equipped with performance sails, bowsprit, and bow thruster, it ensures precise manoeuvrability. Notable upgrades include a Flir mast-mounted thermal camera integrated with the Raymarine Axiom Pro 9S chart plotter. The vessel's construction features coppercoat antifoul and the innovative hydraulic swing-up keel.

6 Spirit of Feeling 44 West Harbour Berth 31 £145,000 Chausey

This Feeling 44 was built in 2002 and is in excellent condition. Her lift keel allows a minimal draft of just 2ft3in, perfect for exploring remote regions. Offering a three-cabin layout with two heads compartments and an excellent galley, it features an innovative chart table arrangement. The saloon, seated for eight, is illuminated by large windows. The deck equipment includes lazyjacks, a stainless steel plough anchor, and various navigational aids. This boat, ideal for passage-making with a refined sailing performance.

This well-maintained year 2000 vessel is equipped with numerous upgrades including a bow thruster, generator, and new sails, along with coppercoat. The interior offers six berths across two double cabins, featuring abundant natural hardwood, excellent ventilation, and comprehensive amenities such as Webasto heating. Powered by a Yanmar 4JH3BE engine, serviced annually, with a slew of electrical and navigation systems.

8 Wicked Witch Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 349 Berth H236 £99,750

This is a well-maintained 2014 model. Featuring a standard fin keel, two-cabin layout, teak fit-out, bow thruster, electric windlass, electric primary winch, heating, and B&G electronics, this boat is well-equipped for comfortable sailing. It also boasts low engine hours and has been serviced recently. With solid teak interior, extensive galley, and advanced navigation equipment, it offers excellent value.

9 Lady Grey Bavaria 33 Berth C42 £94,950

Built in 2016. The Bavaria Cruiser 33 is a well constructed and laid out family cruiser. They are easy to sail with rewarding performance. "Lady Grey" presents in a lovely condition and benefits from a huge inventory including cabin heating, autopilot, AIS, fully battened mainsail and much more. Offering up to 6 berths with two separate sleeping cabins, all finished with light oak woodwork, plus central heating!

10 Fanfare Holman 48 Berth B20 £95,000

1964 Holman 48 - a beautiful flush deck cruiser designed by Kim Holman with comfortable accommodation, nice manners, easy motion and a good turn of speed. A beautiful 1958 classic blue water cruising yacht with elegant lines. Built in Holland by Scheepswerf Kok to a design by Henk Tingen her robust steel construction inspires confidence in her crew wherever she voyages. From Vancouver to Cape Horn, the Falklands to Newfoundland, Iceland, Scotland and Scandinavia she is a well-travelled and well-proven vessel and ready for more adventures. Her moderate draft long keel with lifting centreplate combines shallow water capability with good windward performance.

15 Moonstruck Ronautica 40 Berth D65 £64,950

Moonstruck is a desirable standard draft of the cruiser racer Ronautica RO400 built in 2006. She has been in her current ownership since 2021 and has been well maintained. She is at home offshore racing as much as she is entertaining and cruising in coastal waters. The cockpit is as versatile as the vessel herself. A foldaway central table enables good room for a racing layout or can be used for cockpit entertaining.

16 Ripple Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 35 Sales Area £58,000

Built in 2004. Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 35 is a Marc Lombard design with sparkling performance, yet is still an easily handled cruiser with spacious accommodation. Ripple was supplied new by Clarke & Carter to her current owner. She has the shoal keel and three cabins outside the saloon layout offering 8 berths in total. Diesel central heating give all year capability. Full navigation suite.

17 Pickle Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 37 Berth E129 £54,950

This is a three cabin outside the saloon layout, Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 37 built in 2001. She benefits from the shoal fin keel, ideal for the East Coast, plus a comprehensive navigation suite of instruments, central heating, and much more. Well worth inspection. Last surveyed in 2014 when vendor purchased. Growing family commands a bigger replacement boat!

18 Colette Beneteau Oceanis Clipper 361 Berth M368 £49,950

Built in 2001. This popular Beneteau Oceanis Clipper 361 is a fantastic all round cruising yacht. She has a spacious and well equipped interior, great for a family or entertaining guests. All the lines are led aft into a safe cockpit which makes it easy for sailing short handed. "Colette" is the spacious 3 cabin version offering up to eight berths, B&G electronics, comprehensive safety equipment and has the benefit of a Bruntons Autoprop.

This Dufour 38 Classic has had only two owners from new since her built in 1998. She was last surveyed in 2023 and all recommendations carried out. Three double cabins outside the saloon layout, two heads compartments, central heating all in a comfortable interior. She has an excellent suite of navigation equipment. The 40hp engine has a new saildrive seal. A large boat for a reasonable investment.

20 Blue Lion Hallberg-Rassy 312 Berth N383 £48,000

Built in 1992. The timeless Hallberg Rassy 312 is a medium displacement cruising yacht with seakindly, well mannered performance and a comfortable layout below deck. Easily handled, these attractive cruisers are as happy coastal cruising as they are crossing oceans. "Blue Lion" is ready to be sailed away today. Last surveyed in 2018. Only for sale due to the vendors advancing age.

21 Time Flies Sigma 362 Berth E114 £44,995

Built in 1989. The Sigma 362, designed by David Thomas, has proved to be a fast, well mannered and easily handled family cruiser, a delight to sail. The spacious layout below is both practical and sea manlike, whether at sea or in harbour. "Time Flies" was originally supplied new by Clarke & Carter and has enjoyed a life of good maintenance and constant upgrading. Full list of upgrades available.

22 White Pearl Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 32i Berth E134 £44,950

The Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 32i is a Philippe Briand designed family cruiser which is easy to sail, with excellent performance and a comfortable spacious interior. "White Pearl" was supplied by Clarke & Carter from new and presents well. She has a good inventory and is the standard deep keel, two cabin owners layout.

23 Carina Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 33i Berth G216 £42,500

This Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 33i is the two cabin version with the standard deep fin keel. "Carina" was supplied new by Clarke & Carter and had been in the same Club ownership from new. She has been well used but offers up a good opportunity to buy a fantastic sailing boat for a modest price.

24 Tante Helena Bayaria 34 Berth H245 £42.500

Built in 2001. It's no wonder the Bavaria 34 continues to be a popular family cruising yacht; they are easily handled, have good performance and boast a comfortable and spacious layout below deck. This two cabin version has been well maintained from new and is now only for sale due to a change in circumstances. Furling mainsail and genoa make her a joy to handle. 28hp engine is serviced regularly.

Built in 2003. The Bavaria 32 is a well known and deservedly popular family cruiser, easy to sail with a good turn of speed and excellent accommodation below deck. Two sleeping cabins outside the saloon, 2017 standing rigging and sail drive diaphragm changed in 2024. The boat has been lightly used over the past couple of years. The internal helm makes for comfortable sailing in poor weather & extended seasons. "Charlotte Rose" has been in her current ownership for 14 years and has been well maintained by her owner over the years and is in excellent condition for her age.

29 Slipaway Cornish Crabbers 22 Sales Area £35,000

Built in 2009. The Crabber 22 is strongly built boat with a clean and simple interior that is light and airy and can accommodate up to four persons. Traditional gaff rig with gaff mainsail, foresail and staysail, she is a delight to sail. Her inboard diesel engine makes life simple when the wind drops off.

30 Cu Na Mara Contessa 32 Sales Area £34,950

Built in 1991. Rare opportunity to purchase a late M J Slack moulded Contessa 32 at a very competitive price. 'Cu Na Mara' has been well cared for and is a nice example of these ever popular classic yachts. Her inventory includes central heating, Monitor self steering system, hull epoxied in 2024, B&G instruments and much more.

Built in 2003. The Legend 306 offers spacious accommodation for up to six, it features two double sleeping cabins, an L-shaped galley, and a saloon with convertible dinette. Navigation aids include Raymarine and Simrad equipment. The boat is presented in excellent condition and is ready to sail.

32 Roc Open 40 Sales Area £29,995

Built in 1986. This water ballasted Open 40 has been designed for short-handed offshore racing and passage-making. Roc is strongly built in aluminium to cope with any weather conditions and keep going, no matter what. She has completed three OSTARs, three Round Britain & Ireland races (2-handed), three AZABs, the RORC Fastnet (2-handed), the Bermuda One Two, with a number of wins and many good placings. Alongside her racing, she has also proved to be a fast and easily handled cruising yacht.

33 Aloha Hanse 33 I Berth C44 £28,500

This is a 1999 example of the Hanse 331. Aloha is a comfortable six berth cruising yacht that sails well and easy to handle with her self tacking jib. Her shallow draft wing keel suits cruising the East Coast very well. She is a well equipped boat that is ready for the new owner to sail away today!

34 Amani Dufour 32 Classic Berth L338 £27,500

The Dufour 32 Classic is a practical and comfortable family cruiser. "Amani" was built in 1999 and has only been lightly used and locally cruised and is now for sale as he is retiring from sailing. She has 2024 mainsail and furling genoa, six berths with a double aft cabin and comprehansive cruising specification. Her moderate shoal draft keel is ideal for exploring the shallow waters of the East Coast and beyond.

35 Aloha Beneteau First 25.7 Berth E137 £27,500

Aloha is fast and fun to sail, is an excellent weekender, club racer and coastal cruiser with a modern layout. She has a fantastic sail wardrobe plus a winter storage trailer - an enticing package. The lifting keel makes this an ideal boat for the shallow waters of the East Coast.

36 Katire Beneteau First 285 Berth F178 £22,750

This is the shoal draft version of the popular Beneteau First 285 built in 1988. She has been well cared for by her owner and her interior is has recently been completely overhauled, engine professional top end rebuild and service plus really good canvas work. Four berths in open plan layout with a double aft cabin. She is perfectly set up for single handed sailing and is presented in a ready to go and excellent condition!

Built in 1992. The Tamarisk 29 is a modern GRP version of the classic Falmouth working boat. A comfortable and safe cruising yacht with a sound pedigree. She offers up to 5 berths in a traditional layout with separate heads compartment to starboard with a marine toilet & basin. In the saloon there is a U-shaped settee to starboard with handy storage. Forward facing chart table to starboard with instruments and control panel. She is need of some cosmetic works to the exterior to bring her back to her usual sparkling condition.

38 Crossjack VI Freedom 33 Berth I 264 £18,500

Built in 1989. The Freedom 33 is a seagoing Cat sloop, designed by Garry Hoyt from the USA. Crossjack is perfect for fast, short-handed cruising. The spacious and well laid out teak interior offers 5/6 comfortable berths with two double cabins. The boat is a great east coast cruiser with her shallow draft. Freedom Yachts are unique for their proven un-stayed masts that gives an easy to handle rig with great sailing performance.

39 Rising Hope Buchanan 30 Berth G197 £18,000

This Buchanan 30 would be ideal for joining the Classic regatta circuit. Built in 1960. She has been optimised for racing and has the quick, well-mannered performance we all expect from an Alan Buchanan design. The accommodation offers up to four berths. Full width galley. Origo two burner alcohol hob. Stainless steel sink with electrically pumped water supply with manual back up. Lovely to look at and sails like a dream, Rising Hope will attract attention wherever she goes.

40 Lorikeet Swallow Yachts Bay Raider Expedition Sales Area £17,950

Built in 2015. The Bay Raider Expedition from Swallow Yachts is a traditionally styled trailer/sailer built to a high standard and utilising the best of modern materials and design making them easy to handle and fun to sail. The small cabin forward provides overnight accommodation making the boat more versatile than an open daysailor and she comes complete with a new road trailer.

41 Rose of Arden Harrison Butler 30 Berth B26 £17,500

This beautiful Harrison Butler 30 was built in Whisstocks of Woodbridge in 1938/39. Her graceful curved raked bow and counter canoe stern, turns heads where ever she goes. "Rose of Arden" Has been well maintained by her current owner of 24 years and is in full commission. The accommodation offers up to four berths in a traditional layout. Three 2019 sails included in good inventory.

42 Morven Contest 33 Sales Area £15,500

Built in 1973 she belies her age! The Contest 33 is a well-designed and fast family cruiser with good performance and a comfortable interior. 'Morven' has been well maintained and is a fine example of this classic yacht. She is ready for long distance cruising next season. 5 berth layout, 2019 engine and last surveyed in 2019 with all recommendations done. Well worth inspection.

44 Shearwater Hunter Ranger 245 Berth D85 £14,950

Built in year 2000. An easily handled family cruiser, the Hunter Ranger 245 has good accommodation with six berths within its modest overall length. She is designed by the famous David Thomas, with his boats being well known for their outstanding sailing ability. Hull was copper coated in 2021. Self tacking jib system and stack pack mainsail system for easy short handed cruising.

45 Rolling Mist Westerly Regatta 260 Berth G202 £13,500

Built in 1992. The Westerly Regatta 260 is a compact and easily managed cruising yacht, perfect for the shallow waters of the east coast. "Rolling Mist" is ready for her new owner to sail away. Rarely seen on the market, the Regatta 260 was the replacement for the Westerly Griffon. The current owner has fitted a furling code zero. Six berth layout, 10hp diesel engine with Bruntons varifold propeller, electric anchor windlass and good electronics.

46 Vivendi SHE C32 Sales Area £12,500

Built in 1973. The SHE C32 is another beautifully designed sailing boat by Sparkman & Stephens. She is fast, agile and perfectly set up for long distance cruising. The previous owner put this to the test when he sailed to the Faeroes and back! "Vivendi" benefits from many extras including a new Nanni engine fitted in 2024! The boat is being sold due to a sudden change in circumstances.

47 Osprey of Exe Leisure 29 Sales Area £12,000

This 1982 built Leisure 29 is the twin bilge keel version of this stoutly constructed cruising yacht. She has been in her present ownership for 27 years and has cruised the East Coast. Presented in good order she is well worth inspection. Six berths in traditional layout, 2005 Volvo 18hp diesel engine, plus full navigation kit all included. These boats are timeless and will go on for years and years!

48 Sirius of Avon Trintella 29 Sales Area £11,995

Built in 1969. The Trintella 29 is a long-keeled heavy displacement offshore cruising yacht with elegant traditional lines. A classic van de Stadt design with quick, well-mannered performance and legendary seaworthiness. This example has a 2017 diesel engine, with an accomodation boasting varnished teak joinery and offers up to five berths in two cabins. Eberspacher diesel fired central heating system.

Built in 1968. The Trintella 29 has five berths in traditional layout. Hydranet mainsail and furling genoa plus a cruising chute. This excellent example has been beautifully maintained and upgraded throughout her long ownership and is presented for sale in sail away condition. Probably the best we've seen, so don't hesitate to view.

50 Moonshadow Hunter Legend 240 Sales Area £10,500

Built in 2001. The Hunter Legend 240 is fun to sail, east to trailer and a snap to set up. These little pocket cruisers are perfect for exploring the beautiful coastline of the UK with the aid of her lifting keel and integral water ballast. "Moonshadow" boasts some new sails and upgraded electronics plus a decent road trailer and four comfortable berths in a simple and well laid out interior.

51 Bam Artekno H-35 Sales Area £9,950

Artekho H-35 is a Finnish built cruiser-racer of proven design and respected sailing performance. Bam was built in 1980, this example was displayed at the 1981 London Boat Show. The boat is particularly easy to sail with a light helm and all lines led aft to the deep safe cockpit. Recent upholstery, head linings, coppercoat to hull and a new Genoa in 2023. A boat that draws admiration wherever she goes - fantastic value for money.

52 Pickled Herring One Design Squib 19 Sales Area £9,750

Built by Rondar Boats in 2017, sail number 902, the National Squib is a 19 foot (6m) One Design keelboat. The class was first launched in 1967 in the UK and more than 880 have since been built. The Squib class is one of the five most popular racing classes in the UK with National Championships regularly attracting over 100 boats and many local fleets on the East Coast. 2017 sails (lightly raced), excellent road trailer, light weight rudder and modern running rigging layout she can be competitive in the right hands!

53 Twilight Starlight 30 Berth D78 £9,500

Built in 1979. The Starlight 30 is the cruising version of the Michael Pocock designed half tonner, so has a good performance with spacious accommodation with 4 berths below. Twilight has a 2010 Yanmar diesel inboard engine. Presented in smart condition with a light and airy interior with 4 berth, last surveyed in 2018, she must be viewed to be appreciated. Possible club racing potential all within a small budget.

54 Renegade UFO 34 Berth N378 £8,750

Built in 1977. The UFO 34 is a very tough offshore cruiser that has a racing record over the years that proves they are a quick boat under sail. They are very powerful upwind. Renegade is competitively priced to reflect her cosmetic condition, however she is ready to take her new owner on many adventures. Do have a look and bring offers.

55 Verlocity Verl 900 Sales Area £8,500

Built in 1979. The Verl 900 is a well tested design with good performance and a balanced helm. Easy to sail shorthanded with a seakindly motion and moderate draft, these make great family cruisers. Verlocity has been well cared for and is ready to sail away. Six berths, 16hp engine, five sails all add up to fantastic value for money.

56 Smaug Sweden Yachts C38 Sales Area £5,000




TRIP HAZARDS
