This Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 469 was supplied new in 2014 and has only had two owners since. She benefits from being the performance version meaning she has excellent sails and upgraded deck gear. Numerous upgrades including solar panels, radar and TV aerial. This Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 469 is a Philippe Briand design and is a capable long distance cruiser.

2 Moonshine Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 45 DS East Area £145,000

This Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 45DS has an excellent spec for easy short-handed cruising with her inmast furling and plenty of entertaining space in her large cockpit and deck saloon for the six she accommodates in comfort. In her current ownership she has mainly been used on the east and south coasts of the UK. Moonshine is a 2007 model with three cabins and two heads.

3 Arctic Tern Southerly 115 MkIV Sales Area £138,500

'Arctic Tern' is a well-maintained example of the Southerly 115 MkIV, having had a thorough refit by Northshore in 2023 after her current owner purchased her. Work included blasting the underwater surfaces, Coppercoating the hull and repainting the keel, as well as renewing the standing rigging, servicing the seacocks and any other jobs raised by the survey. At the same time, a new Raymarine Axiom plotter was installed at the helm with an AIS transponder and a new Rutland wind generator installed.

4 Ningaloo Hanse 385 Berth HI £138,500

The Hanse 385 was their best-selling model between 2011 and 2016 and it is easy to see why. During her current ownership she has proved genuinely easy to sail, aided by the self-tacking jib, whilst retaining surprisingly fast passage speeds. Ningaloo boasts a great inventory including recently upgraded cruising laminate sails, a gennaker, full B&G navigation suite, folding propeller, solar panel and plenty more.

5 Southerly Gem Southerly 115 MkIV Sales Area £129,500

'Southerly Gem' is the first of the Southerly 115 Series 4 making the most of the class's continual development since the first Southerly 115 was built in 1983. Developed with many features to give her a stylish and modern look, the large centre cockpit provides both comfort and safety for the crew. The well proven Rob Humphreys designed swing keel and twin rudders on the Series 4, improved the performance of the 115 and is still able to sail in less than three feet of water. 'Southerly Gem' has been in her current ownership for 12 years and proved to be a comfortable cruiser easily handled by two people.

6 Freebooter Freedom 47 Pilothouse Sales Area £69,995

Freebooter was custom-built by Freedom Yachts as a highly capable blue water cruising yacht, with a Cat Schooner rig ideal for short-handed sailing. She is believed to be the only one of her kind, having been built to a very high specification for her first owner including electric primary winches and windlass, bow thruster, black and grey water holding tanks, and integrated beaching legs. Featuring a spacious and easily adapted layout ideal for extended or liveaboard cruising, if you are looking for an easily managed offshore capable cruising yacht with huge uncluttered decks she represents a rare opportunity and fantastic value in our opinion!

The Tradewind 35 is one of John Rock's superb designs that was approved for the 2018 Golden Globe Race. They are highly regarded as a safe and comfortable offshore cruiser with a superb turn of speed. Mahala is beautifully maintained and in excellent condition. She has a wonderful teak interior with teak and holly strip floor. The hull was moulded in 1997 and first launched in 2004 after a full professional fitout by Priors Boatyard. Must be viewed to be appreciated.

8 Liberty Beneteau Oceanis 323 Berth C17 £52,500 Clipper

The Beneteau Oceanis 323 is a highly regarded comfortable modern cruising yacht, considered by many to be the best all-round combination of accommodation and performance in it's class. 'Liberty' is a lightly used example and has clearly been maintained to an excellent standard by her present and previous owners. She has an impressive inventory including bow thruster, electric windlass, diesel heating, holding tank, cockpit tent and fitted cushions, chart plotter, autopilot and more. Early viewing is highly recommended as yachts of this calibre are rare to the market and in high demand.

9 Jal Amande Bavaria 36 Sales Area £49,950

The Bavaria 36 offers class-leading accommodation with a particularly spacious forward cabin and very generous storage. 'Jal Amande' is fitted with the sought-after larger engine, shoal draft keel, and inmast furling mainsail and is also the preferred owner's version offering two double sleeping cabins combined with a spacious saloon, aft galley, and lots of storage.

10 Monet Sigma 38 Sales Area £40,000

The Sigma 38 was a popular cruiser racer when launched, its design allowed for comfortable fast cruising with a manageable rig and a strong hull. They had a keen following among the racing community. Currently owned and operated by Premier Sailing for the Award winning Sail4Macmillan around Britain trips. The latest trip finished on 22nd June. The vessel is now cleaned and ready for a new adventure. She would be ideal as a family cruising/racing boat or to be put to work as she currently is.

II Kingfisher Beneteau Oceanis 35 I Sales Area £39,950

The Beneteau Oceanis 351 offers a great balance of luxurious accommodation combined with seakindly cruising performance. 'Kingfisher' is a desirable twin aft cabin version, offering comfortable sleeping accommodation for up to 8, a spacious saloon, and a large linear galley. She has been well maintained including new sails in 2023 and standing rigging in 2020, and her impressive inventory also includes an electric windlass, diesel heating, autopilot, and AIS radar.

12 Rondo Ronautica RO330 Berth D6 £39,000

The Ronautica RO330 was imported in to the UK and marketed as the Europa RO330 for a while. The RO330 is primarily a fast family cruiser in the same vein as the First 310, First 31.7, First 33.7, Sun Fast 32 or X-302. She has a well-ballasted hull and high ballast ratio (40%) with a reasonably large sail area. "Rondo" is a very good example, presented in excellent condition, with the larger 29hp engine, feathering propeller and recent sails.

13 Galliver SIGMA 38 Sales Area £35,000

The Sigma 38 was a popular cruiser racer when launched, its design allowed for comfortable fast cruising with a manageable rig and a strong hull. They had a keen following among the racing community. Currently owned and operated by Premier Sailing for the Award winning Sail4Macmillan around Britain trips. The latest trip finished on 22nd June. The vessel is now cleaned and ready for a new adventure. She would be ideal as a family cruising/racing boat or to be put to work as she currently is.

14 Cereros Hunter Channel 31 Sales Area £34,950

Cereros is a well finished, twin keeled Hunter Channel 31. She was fitted out from a kit to a high standard and she appears to be professionally finished. This could be the ideal family cruiser for exploring the shallows of the East coast or even further! She has always been a locally owned boat and well cared for. This is evident when you walk on board.

Currently owned and operated by Premier Sailing for the Award winning Sail4Macmillan around Britain trips. The latest trip finished on 22nd June. The vessel is now cleaned and ready for a new adventure. She would be ideal as a family cruising/racing boat or to be put to work as she currently is.

16 Cicero Moody 31 MkII Berth D33 £29,000

The Moody 31 Mkll is a popular family cruiser with accommodation for six and good sailing performance. 'Cicero' is the wheel steering version and benefits from many upgrades and improvements over recent years. Some of the work carried out in a 2021/22 refit included new keel bolts, new headlinings, new hull stripes, all old antifouling removed and repainted and new Raymarine electronics. More recently she has had a new propeller as well as cutless bearing and stern gland, chainplates re-bedded, new diesel heater, new TV and solar panel. 'Cicero' has been very well maintained throughout her life and is presented in very good condition for her age.

17 Sorcerer II Hanse 301 Berth C £24,950

The Hanse 301 is known for its sleek design without compromising internal space. Being easy to sail short-handed with the furling self-tacking jib and excellent sea keeping abilities make for a safe family boat. The wing keel keeps the draft low whilst offering similar stability and performance to a long fin. 1999 build.

18 Regatta Blue Westerly Regatta 290 Berth D18 £22,500

The Westerly Regatta 290 was a modernised version of the Merlin, with a sugar scoop transom, fractional rig and much uprated and redesigned interior woodwork and layout. This example is presented in excellent condition and ready to go. She benefits from plenty of upgrades in recent years including new standing and running rigging in 2023, new stainless steel fuel tank in 2024 and a new mainsail in 2024. Her head linings were also replaced in 2024.

The unsinkable Etap 24i is a well-built and cleverly designed sailing boat. She has twin rudder and a fin keel which offers a fine performance for a single-handed sailor. Offering four berths in a light and airy interior, she features an inboard sail drive diesel engine, heating, shore power and many other upgrades.

20 Orion Beneteau First 285 Sales Area £15,500

This is the wing keel version of the popular Beneteau First 285, giving her shallow draft ideal for East Coast cruising. She has a Volvo 18hp diesel engine and benefits from a new mast and standing rigging in 2015. The First 285 offers performance family cruising with a large cockpit and two double cabins outside of the saloon.

21 Diaton Moody 29 Berth B34 £15,000

Diaton is an very good example of the ever-popular Moody 29, offering impressive accommodation and a safe, comfortable cockpit. She has had many updates over the years including a replacement engine, upgraded electronics, warm air heating, self-tailing winches, new upholstery and more. There is a 2020 survey available to interested parties.

22 Fifty Shades Custom Artekno H-35 Sales Area £14,950

The Artekno H-35 is a Finnish built cruiser-racer of proven design and respected sailing performance. The interior may be quite small by modern 35 footer standards, due to her modest beam but this is made up for by her sparkling performance and excellent stability. The boat is particularly easy to sail with a light helm and all lines led aft to the deep safe cockpit. 'Fifty Shades' has many recent improvements including new engine in 2017, new standing rigging and interior refit under her current ownership. A very well presented yacht, ready to go.

23 Three Fortunes Westerly Konsort Berth C9 £14,500

Three Fortunes is a bilge keel example of the ever popular Westerly Konsort built in 1986. She is presented in good condition for her age with recent upgated s in hading new standing rigging in 2024, new cooker 2022 and the left of the annulotte-indeal for exploring the East Coast, the twin keel Konsort is a space of family cruising boat with good headroom throughout.

24 Barbarian Cork 1720 Sales Area £13,000

The Hunter Horizon 272 is an excellent family cruiser, balancing ample accommodation whilst maintaining well thought of sailing performance. Benefiting from a twin keel design she really is at home on the shallow East coast exploring rivers and inland water ways. "Firefly" is a very good example of a well maintained, factory finished Horizon 272.

26 Etherea of Westerly Griffon Sales Area £9,995 Hamble

The Westerly Griffon was built to replace the hugely successful Centaur and offers an excellent combination of capable cruising performance (much improved from the Centaur), great handling, and superb accommodation for their size. 'Etherea of Hamble' is well set up for shorthanded sailing and twin bilge keels make her ideal for East coast cruising.

27 Picaroon of Ohlson 8.8 Sales Area £9,950 Burnham

The Ohlson 8.8, not to be confused with the Ohlson 29, was designed by Einar Ohlson in the late 1960's as a comfortable, sea-worthy family cruising boat capable of sleeping six people. For her era, she has a high-performance hull that is easily driven to windward and proved successful at the time. 'Picaroon' has been in her current ownership for nearly 20 years and has been well maintained by her professional engineer owner. She has proved to be a very quick yacht and a delight to sail.

28 Kephi Hunter Horizon 27 TK Sales Area £9,950

The Hunter Horizon 27 is a popular family cruising yacht offering modern, spacious feeling accommodation along with Hunter's well-regarded superior part of pance. "Kephi" is a factory completed Horizon 27 with the sough aft pawie by the space of pance and the ability to take the ground S to a paral ISM inboard diesel and was epoxied in 2000 as a preventative measure. Kephi" has been well maintained and is a good example of her class, with a 2023 survey available to interested parties.

29 Sea Baz Jeanneau Fantasia 27 Sales Area £9,950

The Jeanneau Fantasia 27 is well known for providing a large volume of living space for its 27 ft size. As a capable cruising boat 'Sea Baz' has been used to sail across the North Sea to the continent on several occasions. 'Sea Baz' is the lift keel version of the Fantasia reducing her draft from 5'8" to 2'8", allowing you to venture where others can't. Her inventory includes an electric windlass, radar, central heating and liferaft.

30 Silver Pearl Sadler 26 Berth B16 £9,950

The Sadler 26 is a well-proven design with good accommodation and sea kindly performance, which with the double skinned construction makes them warm, dry and unsinkable! "Silver Pearl" has been well maintained by her current owner who has not had the time to use her recently, hence the reason for sale. Recent improvements include a new engine in 2021 and new standing rigging in 2022.

31 Presto MG C27 Sales Area £7,950

The MG C27 is a fast and agile cruiser from the board of Rob Humphreys, with a blend of responsiveness, easy handling and good manners that few can resist. The practical layout includes a separate heads aft, good sized galley and aft double cabin. 'Presto' is the lift keel version of the MG C27 making her ideal for exploring the East Coast rivers and utilising shallow/drying moorings, with the lifting keel reducing the draft from 5'10" to 3'2". She has been well maintained including new standing rigging in 2022 and the keel mechanism was overhauled in 2019.

32 Rozinante Sailfish 25 Sales Area £4,995

The Sailfish 25, designed by Angus Primrose, offers a spacious, moderately fast small cruiser, with the major advantage of being able to explore shallow estuaries and to use cheaper drying moorings due to her lifting keel, which reduces the draft from 3'7" to 13". 'Rozinante' had her engine completely overhauled over the winter of 2023/24 and the lift keel mechanism was also overhauled at the same time. She would be a good alternative to anyone looking at a Westerly Centaur or similar.

33 Outlaw One Design Squib 19 Sales Area £2,000

Hunter built SQUIB 19 Racer. Sail number 595. Fin keel. Fractional sloop rig. Tiller steering. The National Squib is the most popular One Design keel boat class in the U.K. The class is very strong with fleets racing throughout the U.K. and active Open, National and Regional regattas.

34 Chemar Trader 535 Signature Alongside D £220,000 Pontoon

The Trader 535 is a modern classic, combining stylish yet practical lines with excellent sea keeping, great versatility, frugal running costs, and a practical line with excellent sea keeping, great versatility, frugal running costs, and a practical interior Real for long-term cruising, often favourably compared to Cratio 32 and Bloom livals. Greenar is still in her original ownership since new aid if the A. paid with a huge specification including generator, watermaker, hydraulic passerelle/crane, reverse-cycle air conditioning, holding tank, hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, electric windlass, aft hardtop, long-range fuel tanks and much, much more.

35 Ragnar Broom 42 CL Sales Area £169,950

The Broom 42 CL is well known for its sea keeping and long distance cruising abilities. In her current ownership, she has been on several trips across the North Sea to France, Belgium and Holland, where the owners have enjoyed holidaying on the inland waterways. The current owners have made some useful upgrades to the boat and this 2003 model is presented in excellent condition.

36 Arazi Beneteau Antares 9 OB Berth Cl0 £114,500

The Beneteau Antares 9 OB offers fast family cruising in a modern package, with wide side decks, excellent panoramic visibility from the wheelhouse and the Beneteau Air Step hull design. 'Arazi' is a high specification Offshore example with many factory fitted extras including gas stove, fridge, shore power, microwave, larger fuel tanks, plus bow and stern thrusters. With low hours for a 2018 boat, 'Arazi' is well worth viewing.

37 No Name Iron 767 Sales Area £100,000

The IRON 767 is a rough and ready sports boat with a purpose built performance hull by Mannerfelt Design. Twinned with the Yamaha F300 drive by wire outboard boat, handling and speed are top of the priority list for the new owner. Benefitting from Yamaha's Helm Master system, smart trim and joystick controls it will manoeuvre effortlessly dock side and in the open sea.

38 No Name Sealine F34 Berth D8 £99,000

39 Pangea Princess 420 Berth B49 £89,950

The Princess 420 is regarded as a comfortable and spacious flybridge cruiser, suitable for family use and offshore trips, known for its handling, visibility, and the quietness of the engines. The accommodation offers a well-appointed interior with a bright, airy saloon and large forward owner's cabin with en-suite heads. Pangea has been in her current ownership since 2020 and while having a major engine service at that time, she has had very little use since, hence the reason for sale. The asking price reflects the need for another engine service & other mostly cosmetic works required to bring her back up to scratch.

40 No Name SeaRay SPX230 Sales Area £59,500
